Tennis Court Rules and Regulations

### Definitions and restrictions

Courts open:	7 days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 10 p.m.
In-Season prime time:	October 1 to April 30, 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
Off-Season:	May 1 to September 30

### Court Usage

In-season:	Prime time in-season usage is reserved for <i>residents, overnight guests</i> or <i>lessee</i> (when leasing a unit the owner forfeits his/her rights to the use of Town Center amenities). <i>Daytime guests</i> are permitted to play after 12:30 p.m. provided the host resident is playing/present.
Off-season:	<i>Daytime guests</i> are permitted to play at all times, provided the host resident is playing/present.

### Lights

Lights may be turned on at each individual court as required. Lights will automatically shut off at 10:00 p.m. However, players are to turn off lights when finished.

### Reservation Procedures

All court reservations are made at [www.villagewalkbonita.com](http://www.villagewalkbonita.com) home page. The earliest a sign-up can be made is one (1) week in advance of your reservation time. Your court will be reserved in your name per your Skedda (scheduling) account. Court reservations are limited to 90 minutes. An individual's name may not appear on the reservation system on any back-to-back time slots in season during prime time. An individual may not book more than three (3) courts in any time slot without being reviewed by the Tennis Committee. Reserved courts are held for 10 minutes and then become available to walk-ons on a first come first served basis, no sign-up required.

Although players are not permitted to play back-to-back in season prime time, exceptions would include such times: when a player participates in open round robin activities or when a player finishes his time slot and a group in the next time slot is short a player. The player can function as a substitute with that group. Substitution would not be permitted on a regular basis because it would not be consistent with the intent of the language.

Please be sure you have made a completed request for your reservation. All reservations must follow the outline below. Any incomplete reservation will be deleted.

A completed request contains three elements:

1. A Login from a Trusted Account Holder
2. A court and time selection within 7 days of the requested court time.

3. A booking containing all players first initial and last name (Your name is not necessary since the reservation is associated to your account login). A reservation must contain a minimum of 2 players in prime time in season. A player may book a court for individual practice after 12:30 in-season or anytime during the off-season.
4. Cancellations should be made in a timely manner so others may sign up for the court.

#### Round Robins

Courts will be blocked out for open round robin play as follows:

##### Men competition

Monday/Wednesday 8:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. (4 courts)

Friday 8:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. (3 courts)

##### Women competition

Tuesday/Thursday 8:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. (3 courts)

##### Mixed competition

Thursday 5:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. (4 courts)-

Saturday 9:30 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. (4 courts)

The tennis committee reserves the right to change the number of courts being blocked off at any time, based on need.

#### Proper Tennis Attire, Behavior and Bicycles, etc.

1. Appropriate tennis attire must be worn at all times. Proper clay court tennis shoes without raised treads are mandatory to prevent damage to court surfaces. Unacceptable attire includes, but is not be limited to, bathing suits, tank tops, cutoff jeans, sandals, running, hard court, and cross training shoes.
2. Courteous behavior and proper language are required. Excessive yelling, noise, profanity and racquet throwing will not be tolerated at any time.
3. Pets, bicycles, roller blades, skateboards, scooters, etc. are not permitted on the courts. Parking of bicycles on the walkway or in the cutouts between the courts is not allowed. All bicycles must be parked in the designated area.

#### League Play

League play has preference over all other play. Courts will be scheduled and reserved by a member of the Tennis Committee or designee(s), who may also fill the role of Skedda (scheduling) monitor(s). The Tennis Committee appoints Skedda monitors. League play may not begin before 11:00 a.m.

### Instructions and Lessons

Professional individual or group instruction may be given to VWB residents and their guests/visitors. Instruction may only be given by Certified USPTA or PTR member. Prior to giving instruction, the instructor must be approved by the HOA Board. These individuals must provide proof of \$1,000,000 in Liability Insurance naming VillageWalk of Bonita and KW Property Management as additional insured.

### Activities

Scheduling of any type of tennis activity (e.g. tournaments, special events, league play, parties, etc.) must be reviewed by the Tennis Committee and the VWB Activities Director. All activities sanctioned by the Tennis Committee will supersede regular play.

### Children

Parents or other supervisory adults will be responsible for their children's behavior at all times on the courts and will be responsible for any damages they may cause. An adult must accompany children under twelve (12) years of age at all times unless participating in an organized tennis program or lesson.

### Court Maintenance

Tennis courts will be groomed and maintained by the VWB Maintenance Personnel. All players are encouraged to brush the courts after each use. Problems with the court surfaces, lines, nets etc. should be reported to the General Manager at [info@villagewalkbonita.com](mailto:info@villagewalkbonita.com).

### Rules Infractions

Rules infractions should be enforced by the players, or reported in writing to the Tennis Committee via the Village Walk Office. Infractions will be dealt with progressively, as needed: verbal, written, loss of court time.
